Again in 2021 there will be no in person tax payment dates. Here are your options for this year:

1.) <u>Mail them in</u>—if you want a receipt, please include a selfaddressed stamped envelope.

2.) **Pay at Hometown Bank in Pardeeville**. You need to have your tax bill/slip with you at the time of payment and they will give you a receipt. They cannot give you a refund.

3.) **NEW**—<u>**Drop box**</u> on the east side of the Town Hall is open and drops directly into a locked safe. It is available to you at all times.
